- 4 We require each group to have full third party insurance cover.
- 5 Kelly Enterprises accept no liability for the welfare of the group whilst staying at or journeying to Nun's Cross Farm.
- 6 **Any loss, damage or abuse of the building, surroundings or contents will be charged direct to the organisation or individual making the booking. This includes cleaning or removal of rubbish. The wood provided is for use in the wood burners, excessive usage will be charged.**
- 7 Booking organisation must accept that the remoteness of the farm and the nature of Dartmoor requires specialist supervision.
- 8 The booking organisation agrees to provide adequate staff supervision of the groups to ensure their safety and good behaviour whilst staying at the farm.

## Nun's Cross Farm - Dartmoor

The house is all that remains of a once prosperous farm, it was last inhabited in the 1950's. This remote building is available for hire to organisations wishing to take full advantage of the moor and enjoy a back to basics' experience.



### Facilities

The facilities are basic and in line with a camping barn. There is a kitchen with a 4 ring gas cooker and various plates, mugs, pots, pans, plates, cooking utensils and cutlery.

There are two downstairs rooms both of which are fitted with wood burners, so the farmhouse can be heated. The wood is provided for the sole use in the wood burners. One room is set up as a dining room with long tables and benches, a great meeting room and somewhere to relax out of the elements. The other room sleeps 9 and is more suited for staff sleeping quarters. Upstairs there are three bedrooms, two larger and one small, sleeping 27 on triple bunk beds.

Mattresses are not supplied, we recommend that groups bring karrimats.

There is no running water to the farm, groups should bring their own drinking water. Water is available in a nearby leat for washing etc.

A chemical toilet and shelter is provided for use outdoors. Disposal of waste and cleaning the toilet is the groups responsibility.

Shallow toilets no more than 20cm deep can be dug outside of the perimeter wall. Water should be used to wet down toilet paper. Holes must be filled in on departure.

### Access

We will post details of the access code prior to your arrival. Access is from 1400 on the day of arrival.

Vehicles are only allowed down the track with the permission of The Adventure Centre. Vehicles should go no further than the gravel track, **do not drive onto the grass. It is against National Park byelaws to drive vehicles off road.**

### Safety

- 1 The shutters upstairs must be open when rooms are in use.
- 2 All gas bottles should be disconnected when not in use and upon departure.
- 3 The front door should be unlocked and all the escape routes kept clear at all times.
- 4 A briefing must be given to the group outlining safety considerations and the emergency procedures.
- 5 Stairs should be illuminated at night. Chemical light sticks are ideal for this purpose.
- 6 Staff must operate the kitchen and take responsibility for hygiene and safety. Chemicals and dangerous objects must be kept out of children's reach.
- 7 In misty conditions it is advised that the group members do not go far from the farm building and that a light is situated at the doorway.

### Departure

- 1 Please ensure the farm is clean and tidy.
- 2 Remove all perishable items and rubbish.
- 3 The bunkhouse should be vacated by 1100.
